We have been here at Garris Road for a little over a year now, and through God's blessing and the many donations we received, the building was purchased on September 16, 2008!

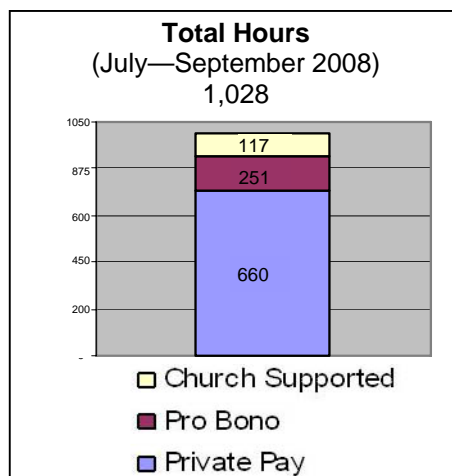
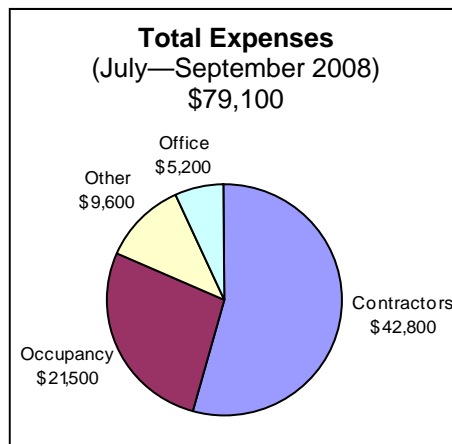
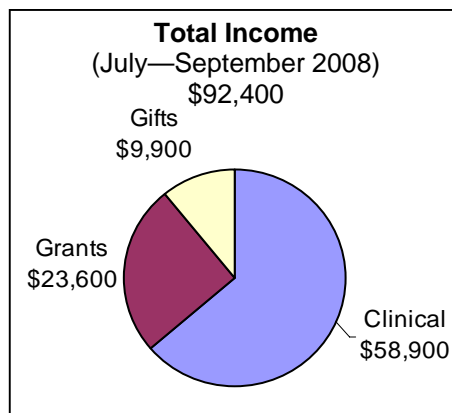
We are looking forward to the day when the building will be fully paid for, enabling us to continue to offer services to those in need throughout the community regardless of their ability to pay.

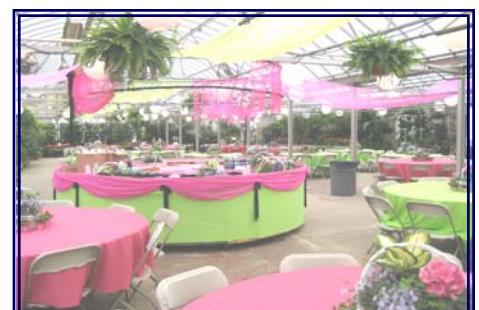
OUR NEEDS:
